Evangelism is more than SAYING certain

things, it is LIVING a certain way

[1 Peter 3:13-15] 13 Now who is there to harm you if you are zealous for what is good? **14** But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, **15** but in your hearts **honor** Christ the Lord as holy ...

Do I LIVE in a way that says Jesus is LORD?

[Colossians 3:23] Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men ...

[John 3:17] For God did not send his Son into the world to **condemn** the world, but in order that the world might be **saved** through him.

[1 Peter 3:15] 15 ... always being **prepared** to make a **defense** to anyone who **asks** you for a reason for the **hope** that is in you ...

Do I SPEAK when I have the OPPORTUNITY?

[1 Peter 3:15 & 16] ... yet do it with **gentleness** and **respect**, **16** having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame.

Do I SHOW honor and respect to those who DON'T BELIEVE?

[Romans 11:13&14] 13 Now I am speaking to you Gentiles... **14** in order somehow to make my fellow Jews **jealous**, and thus save some of them.
